
Fake Emails impersonating Temu

The emails state that you can win free products by simply clicking on a link and completing a quick survey. The link will take you to a realistic looking website that is under the control of the criminals, where they will steal your personal data.

These FAKE Temu emails have been reported over 30,000 times to Action Fraud from across the UK.
