1 in 17 people were victims of fraud in the UK last year. Fraud costs the taxpayer an estimated £6.8 billion per year.

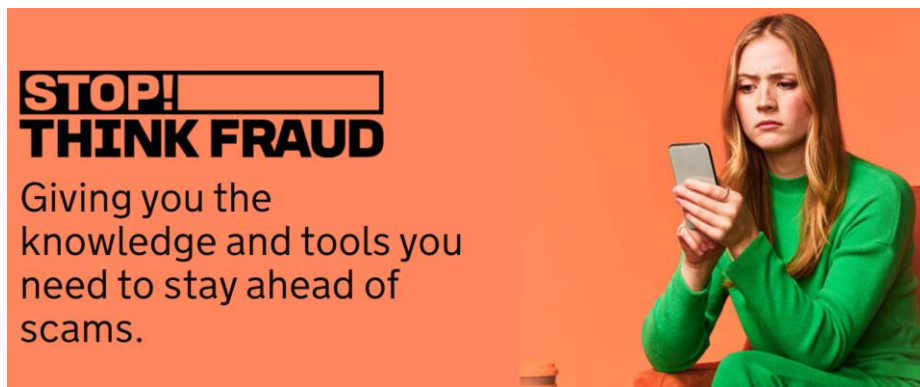
The impact of fraud can be heart breaking, as criminals do not just steal your money but steal your sense of security.
