WhatsApp Crypto Currency Scam

A Kent resident reported to KCC about being scammed with a WhatsApp crypto trading scam. The criminals use WhatsApp to invite you to a group where a fake 'analyst' will talk about the advantages of investing in cryptocurrency.

However, it is all a scam and is designed to steal your money.
